

Awards & Scholarships Overview

A number of Awards & Scholarships are available to organizations, individuals and students who demonstrate their commitment and contribution to the NeuroLeadership field.

- **NeuroLeadership Research Paper of the Year**
This paper will be published in the NeuroLeadership Journal and the author awarded US\$1500 for their contribution
- **The Neuron Award**
This organizational award is announced and presented at the annual Gala Dinner at the NeuroLeadership Summit
- **NeuroLeadership Post Graduate Certificate Scholarship**
Scholarship to participate in the Post Graduate Certificate in the Neuroscience of Leadership program, value US\$12,000
- **NeuroLeadership Summit Scholarships**
Six annual scholarships to attend the NeuroLeadership Summit, value US\$2650
- **NeuroLeadership PGCNL Emerging Economies Partial Scholarships**
Six partial scholarships for the PGCNL are available for individuals from emerging economies, value US\$6,000 each

How to Apply

To apply for one of these NeuroLeadership awards or scholarships:

1. Read through the description and requirements below
2. Download the application form from our website at http://www.neuroleadership.org/institute/Awards_Scholarships.shtml
3. Complete application and submit with relevant attachments (research paper, case study, bio, two-page proposal) to support@neuroleadership.org no later than 30 June.

Research papers and case studies will be submitted to our journal review panel for feedback and final papers incorporating feedback are required to be submitted by 30 July.

Successful applicants will be notified via email, and the awards will be presented at the NeuroLeadership Summit (note: award recipients are not required to attend the Summit).

NeuroLeadership Research Paper of the Year

This paper will be published in the NeuroLeadership Journal and the author awarded US\$1500. The award will be presented at the NeuroLeadership Summit (the author is not required to be at the Summit).

Applicants are required to submit a **Research Paper** up to 6,000 words in length. To be accepted for publication, research papers must contain well-crafted statements based on fully documented original research rather than mere assertions. The award **application form** and the completed **research paper** are to be emailed by 30 June to support@neuroleadership.org for peer review.

The Neuron Award

This organizational award is presented to an organization or consulting firm that has successfully applied the principles of NeuroLeadership across their business. It will be awarded to the organization that can most fully demonstrate it is employing brain-based principles in its practices and that can quantify the positive impact that has been achieved by applying these principles.

The award will be announced and presented at the annual NeuroLeadership Summit Gala dinner and the Case Study published in the NeuroLeadership Journal.

Applicants are required to submit a **Case Study** illustrating how neuroscience is being used to create, improve or measure leadership, coaching or change programs and should be a minimum of 1,500 words and a maximum of 6,000 words. Please include in the submission the Company name, how the case came about, evidence data and how the principles are being applied.

The award **application form** and completed **case study** are to be emailed to support@neuroleadership.org for peer review no later than 30 June. Post Graduate Certificate Scholarship

NeuroLeadership Summit Scholarships

Six scholarships will be awarded to individuals who can demonstrate the contribution they will make to the NeuroLeadership field through their involvement in the NeuroLeadership Summit. The scholarships are for attendance at the NeuroLeadership Summit in the same year and includes a 3 day pass for the Summit (NB: travel, accommodation & visa costs are not included as part of this scholarship and must be borne by the attendee)

- Other related fields

Applicants must submit their **application form** along with a **bio** and a **two-page summary** outlining the contribution they will make to the field through their involvement in the Summit.

Applications are evaluated using a comprehensive review process against the following criteria:

- Distance required to travel
- Contribution to the event
- Current contribution to the field
- Potential future contribution to the field
- Quality of the submission
- Affordability

Post Graduate Certificate Emerging Economies Partial Scholarship

Six partial scholarships will be awarded to applicants from emerging economies. These scholarships offer enrolment in the PGCNL for the reduced price of US\$6,000 (valued at US\$12,000) which can be paid a module at a time in four equal payments.

Applications are due **60 days** prior to intake commencement (intakes in March & October each year). These scholarships are designed for applicants from BRIC (Brazil, Russia, India, China) countries, Africa & other emerging economy countries (to be approved on request).

The scholarships will be awarded to those applicants who can most fully demonstrate the contribution they will make to the NeuroLeadership field through their involvement in the Post Graduate Certificate in the Neuroscience of Leadership.

Applicants must submit their **application form** along with a **bio** and a **two-page summary** outlining the contribution they will make to the field through their involvement in the Post Graduate Certificate.
